From his humble start in Southern Manitoba, Jerry Sereda has worked his way through honkytonks, rodeos, and festivals playing solo or rocking with his band to become a Multi-award winning Canadian country singer with over 1 million online streams.

Jerry has recently released his first single "Backroad Therapy" from his 5th studio album to be released in 2023. Backroad Therapy reached #1 on the International Indigenous Music Countdown, as well as on the Canadian Indie Country Countdown. This new single follows his album "Classic Country Couple" which he released on June 21, 2021 on National Indigenous Peoples day as an homage to his Indigenous heritage. The album ended up winning "Best Country Album" at the Summer Solstice Indigenous Music Awards, and garnered several nominations for the "Manitoba Country Music Awards" including: "Country Album of the Year", "Music Video of the Year", and "Male Artist of the Year".

The all-Indigenous production team — Sereda, award winning producer/songwriter Troy Kokol, and Jamie Lillie -- have recorded an album reflective of Sereda's recent personal and musical evolution. Sereda's inspirations include Garth Brooks, Merle Haggard, Eric Church, and his Grandma Dottie. Dottie taught her grandson his first guitar chords and shared her love of country music with him. Sereda said she was one of his biggest supporters throughout his life.

Growing up in the Parkland region (Treaty 1) of Manitoba, Jerry Sereda learned how to hunt, fish, trap, and live off the land. This is where he also learned the importance of hard work, family, and music. Sereda's first single, "Time," was recorded and released through the support of indigenous music programs. This lit a fire to pursue music as more than just a hobby. His second album "Turn the Country On" garnered nominations and awards at the Indigenous Music Awards, Aboriginal People's Choice Music Awards, Western Canadian Music Awards, and charted several #1 songs on the Indigenous Music Countdown.

After spending time in the fall/winter of 2021 writing songs in Nashville with many successful writers, Jerry continues to work in live in Treaty 1 territory as he, Troy, and Jamie continue work on his 5th studio album to be released in 2023.
